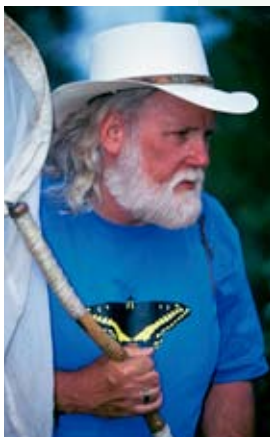
Thursday, October 7th
